## What Class is Best for my Child?

**Pee Wee Tennis: Ages 4-5 years of age**  
QuickStart Tennis-A new play format for learning tennis, designed to bring kids into the game by utilizing specialized equipment, shorter court dimensions and modified scoring, all tailored to age and size. We want them to engage in a fun activity that they can play forever. Limit 8 per class

## Beginner Youth Tennis (ages 6-14)

This is an instructional program designed for beginners to learn the basic skills needed to play tennis. They will be introduced from how to hold the racquet, forehand, backhand, serve, volleys, and how to keep score.

## Intermediate Youth Tennis

(ages 6-14)

Instructional group clinic includes drills to improve their techniques of serves, groundstrokes, and volleys. It will also include the basics of singles and doubles play.

## Tournament Players' Camp

This camp is available to those who play on teams as well as in tournaments. It will develop "your" game. It will also provide athletes an opportunity to become better tennis players in a fun, positive atmosphere.

## Adult Beginner Tennis (ages 15 +)

Whether you have never played tennis before or you are dusting your racquet off from years past. You will get in the groove with our tennis pro and won't be able to put your racquet down again.

## Junior Team Tennis

Involves ongoing development during the summer and fall for advanced and aspiring tennis players. Offers the opportunity to play on teams in leagues that emphasize fun, fitness, and friends. Teams are organized to match players of similar age and ability. Captains' meeting is May 12 at Tupelo Parks and Recreation at 6:00 PM. League play begins May 24 – July 17 (18, 14, 12, 10 & under divisions, advanced and intermediate levels of each). COED teams consist of B&G singles, B&G doubles, and MXD doubles.
