



Rob Leake and C.C. Augustus Pool Rules

Special Groups

Daycare: Ratio is 5:1 (5 children per 1 counselor). Counselors must be aware which children can swim and which ones can't. Counselors are encouraged to go over the rules with their group before they enter the pool. This will help cut down on accidents!

Child Use Policies:

Children 6 and under must have direct in water supervision by a parent/legal guardian. NOTE: LIMIT 3 CHILDREN PER ADULT. This includes being within arms reach of the child at all times. It is the sole responsibility of the Parent or Legal Guardian to insure the safety of the person(s) entrance and exit from Rob Leake City Pool and C.C. Augustus Pool. Any person or persons not able to swim or stand in the pool will not be allowed to swim in said pool unless they are in the water with a Parent/Legal Guardian.

Pool Rules and Regulations

- No cut off pants and NO THONGS. Proper swim attire must be worn (no leotards, sports bras, mesh shorts, street clothes, and underwear must not be seen!) No exceptions. Wear bathing suits only; Indecent Exposure will not be tolerated! No drooped pants; this is strictly prohibited!
- No outside food or drinks in pool area
- MUST PAY TO RE-ENTER FOR ALL REASONS (i.e. but not limited to use cell phone, talk to someone outside the fence, run back out to car for any items forgotten.....)
- No smoking. Anyone who leaves to smoke must pay to re-enter. Must be 25 ft. from building.
- Change diapers in a bathroom and not at poolside
- No refunds! No refunds due to bad weather. Make sure that all patrons are aware of this rule before entering the pool.
- Children under ELEVEN (11) must be accompanied by parent or an adult 18 years of age & above.
 - All swimmers must take shower before entering pool
 - Horseplay, vulgar language, running, pushing, holding others, dunking others will not be tolerated. No throwing objects in the pool or on the pool deck. Pushing people in the pool is not allowed. Running pool area is prohibited.
 - Bottles, glass containers, etc.; are not allowed in pool area
 - Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on park grounds which includes the pool area
 - Writing on walls of bathrooms are prohibited and will result from dismissal from park for the summer
 - No pets allowed
 - Weapons of any kind are prohibited
 - Spitting or spouting of pool water prohibited
 - Non-swimmers must stay in the shallow end of the pool. No Exceptions!
 - No blowing of nose in pool
 - No diving in the shallow end of the pool or in crowded areas. No cartwheels or flips off the sides of the pool.
 - One person on the diving board at a time. No hanging on the ends of the board. Lifeguards will monitor all behavior on the diving boards. No double bounces, no cutaways, no cartwheels or any form of gymnastics. We reserve the right to close the diving boards to have open swim and vice-versa

- Life jackets are available for rental at \$5.00/day
- Due to the availability of Lifeguards, it may be necessary to reduce the number of swimmers allowed in pool area during general swimming. We may also close off certain areas of the pool if inadequate number of staff available.
- Patrons will not enter the pool deck area until a Lifeguard is on duty
- No trespassing after pool hours
- No hanging on the lane lines. The circle pattern, swimming on the right side of the lane, going down and back, will be used during lap swimming. All swimmers will enter the lap pool from the ends only. No diving is permitted from the sides, only feet first entries are allowed in the lap pool. The lap lanes are used for lap swimmers only. There will be no standing around in these areas
- Admissions of patrons will cease thirty (30) minutes prior to closing and must be out of the water in time for the facility to close at the posted time. Whistle will be blown 15 minutes prior to closing
- The Aquatic Staff reserves the right to dismiss any patron not abiding by facility rules, acting in an unsafe manner, or inhibiting the enjoyment of other patrons
- Management reserves the right to refuse admittance or remove from the facility of anyone who is endangering the health and safety of other patrons and employees.
