



Aquatic Facility Policies



- Note: Children 11 years and under must be accompanied by a paying adult (16 years or older) at all facilities.
- Children in diapers are required to wear either a lil' swimmer diaper or plastic pants over their diaper per Health Department Regulations.
- Outside food and drinks may not be brought into the aquatic facilities without permission from the Aquatics Director. (Water excluded)
- Proper swim attire must be worn at all times. Street clothes, such as t-shirts, cut-off shorts, mesh shorts, leotards, underwear, etc. may not be worn in the pool.
- Patrons exiting the facility must pay to re-enter the facility.
- Only coast guard approved floatation devices may be used in the pool. (No rafts, water rings or inflatable toys)
- Smoking is not allowed anywhere within the aquatic facility.
- The aquatic staff reserves the right to dismiss any patron not abiding by facility rules, acting in an unsafe manner, or inhabiting the enjoyment of other patrons.
- Patrons are asked to review more specific rules posted at each facility.
